Central Illinois Mosque and Islamic Center (CIMIC) runs a CIMIC Weekend School (CWS) for area children. While providing the basic knowledge of their religion—including Quran, Aqeedah, Prophet's seerah and Islamic history—an important goal of CWS is to help prepare Muslim youth for a model and active role in the broader, multi-religious society.

**Calendar** (dates are tentative and CIMIC website should be consulted for up to date information)

**Spring Semester:** Starts on the third Sunday of January and ends on the second Sunday of May.

**Fall Semester:** Starts on the third Sunday of August and ends on the second Sunday of December. As the lunar calendar shifts, these dates may vary somewhat.

**Known Holidays:** Besides the Sundays following each of the two Eids, CWS does not meet on the: Last day of the Spring break (Sunday) at the University of Illinois; and Sunday following Thanksgiving Thursday.

**Timings:** CWS meets from 10.30 AM till 1.15 PM on Sundays at CIMIC.

CWS also runs a **CAMP CIMIC** during summer. Please refer to the CIMIC website for more information.

Registration takes place at the beginning of each semester. A registration form is available under the school section of [www.cimic.org](http://www.cimic.org).

**Fee:** \$70 per student per semester (subject to change). Waivers available in lieu of parents help with school activities.

## CIMIC ARABIC SCHOOL (CAS)

In addition to the CWS, Central Illinois Mosque and Islamic Center (CIMIC) also runs a CIMIC Arabic School (CAS) for area children. This is a *language* school for kids. Goals are to prepare children to read and converse in Arabic.

CAS generally meets on Sundays for an hour before the start of CWS (from 9.30 – 10.30 AM).

**Separate registration is required for CAS.**

**Fee:** \$40 per child per semester (subject to change).
