# 10 Days of Dhul Hijjah

## Virtues

Ibn 'Abbas (رضي الله عنه) reported that Rasulullah (ﷺ) said:  
"There are no days in which righteous deeds are more beloved to Allah than these ten days." The people asked, "Not even jihad for the sake of Allah?" He said, "Not even jihad for the sake of Allah, except in the case of a man who went out to fight giving himself and his wealth up for the cause, and came back with nothing (i.e. he is martyred)."

[Bukhari, Tabraani]

Rasulullah (ﷺ) commanded us to recite a lot of Tasbeeh ("Subhan-Allah"), Tahmeed ("Al-hamdu Lillah") and Takbeer ("Allahu akbar") during this time. 'Abdullah ibn 'Umar (رضي الله عنه) reported that

Rasulullah (ﷺ) said:

"There are no days greater in the sight of Allah and in which righteous deeds are more beloved to Him than these ten days, so during this time recite a great deal of Tahleel ("La ilaaha ill-Allah"), Takbeer and Tahmeed."

These ten days include Yawm 'Arafah (the Day of 'Arafah), on which Allah perfected His Religion. Fasting on this day will expiate for the sins of two years. These days also include Yawm al-Nahar (the Day of Sacrifice), the greatest day of the entire year and the greatest day of Hajj, which combines acts of worship in a way unlike any other day.

# Deeds for 10 Days of Dhul Hijjah

## Hajj and 'Umrah

One of the greatest deeds that can be done during these ten days is Hajj to the Sacred House of Allah. Rasulullah (ﷺ) said:

“Whoever performs Hajj and does not commit any obscenity or transgression will return [free from sins] as he was on the day his mother gave birth to him.”

[Bukhari]

Abu Hurairah (رضي الله عنه) reported that Rasulullah (ﷺ) said:  
“The reward for a Hajj mabroor is nothing but Paradise”

[Bukhari and Muslim]

## Fasting during these days

From Abu Sa'id al-Khudri who said that Rasulullah (ﷺ) said:  
No servant (of Allah, the Most High) fasts one day in the Path of Allah, except that Allah, the Most High, removes his face from the Fire because of it (the distance of traveling) seventy years.

[Bukhari and Muslim]

## Qurban (sacrifice of animal)

The slaughtering of a sacrificial animal (Adhiyah) is legislated for the Day of Sacrifice (10th) and the Days of Tashreeq (11th, 12th and 13th). This is the Sunnah of our father Prophet Ibrahim (عليه السلام) - when Allah, the Most High, redeemed Prophet Ibrahim's (عليه السلام) son by the great sacrifice (of an animal in his place).

It is authentically reported that Rasulullah (ﷺ) slaughtered (sacrificed) two horned rams, black and white in colour, and said Takbeer (Allahu Akbar), and placed his foot on their sides (while slaughtering them).

[Al-Bukhari and Muslim]

This is an obligation on each one of us and it represents the beautiful, complete submission of Prophet Ibrahim (عليه السلام) when he chose to obey Allah Ta'ala fully and without question when it came to slaughtering his own son, Prophet Ismail (عليه السلام). Before the knife was able to cut his son's neck, Allah Ta'ala replaced Prophet Ismail (عليه السلام) with a ram from Jannah. Prophet Ismail (عليه السلام) was saved and Prophet Ibrahim (عليه السلام)'s complete submission to Allah's command was accepted.

## Deeds for 10 Days of Dhul Hijjah

It is related by A'isha (رضي الله عنها) that Rasulallah (ﷺ) said, There is nothing dearer to Allah Ta'ala during the days of sacrifice than the sacrificing of animals. The sacrificed animal shall come on the day of Qiyamah with its horns, hair and hooves (to be weighed in reward). The sacrifice is accepted by Allah Ta'ala before the blood reaches the ground. Therefore sacrifice with an open and happy heart.

[Tirmizhi, Ibn Majah]

Zaid ibn Arqam (رضي الله عنه) related that the companions of Rasulallah (ﷺ) asked, "O Rasulallah, what is sacrifice?" He replied, "it is the Sunnah of your father Ibrahim (عليه السلام)". They asked again, "What benefit do we get from it?" he answered, "A reward for every hair of the sacrificed animal." And what reward is there for animals with wool?" they asked. "A reward," he said, 'for every fibre of the wool.'

[Ibn Majah, Musnad Ahmad, Mishkaat]

### Those who do the Qurban, refrain from cutting nails and hair

It has been narrated from Umm Salamah (رضي الله عنها) that Rasulallah (ﷺ) said: If you see the Hilal (new moon) of Zul-Hijjah, and any one of you wants to make a sacrifice, then he should not cut (anything) from his hair and his nails.

### Perform the Eid prayer

It is incumbent for the Muslim (who is not performing Hajj) to make every effort to perform the Eid Prayer wherever it is performed, and to be present for the Khutbah and benefit.

### Doing plenty of voluntary (nafl) righteous deeds of worship
